### LEGISLATIVE UPDATES

#### **COLA announced for 2019**

Based on the latest consumer price data released by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the 2019 cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) for Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS) annuities and Social Security benefits will be 2.8 percent. This is the largest COLA for CSRS retirees and Social Security beneficiaries since 2012. Meanwhile, retirees under the Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS) will not receive the full amount and instead will only receive a 2 percent COLA to their annuities. *Source: NARFE* 

#### **New WEP Reform Bill Introduced**

Reps. Kevin Brady, R-TX, and Richard Neal, D-MA introduced legislation, H.R. 6933, the *Equal Treatment of Public Servants Act of 2018*, to modify the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP). The WEP reduces the Social Security benefits of federal retirees covered by the Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS), and many state and local government retirees covered by similar systems, who earned Social Security benefits through other employment.

Under the bill, starting in 2020, individuals whose Social Security benefits are reduced by the WEP would receive an additional payment of \$100 per month. Individuals receiving a WEP-reduced Social Security benefit based on their spouses' employment would receive an additional \$50 per month. These changes would apply to individuals who turn age 62 prior to 2025.

But individuals who turn age 62 in 2025 (those turning 55 this year) or later would be subject to a new formula designed to more accurately account for earnings based on covered employment, such as in private-sector jobs, compared to earnings from a non-Social Security covered position. This formula would affect each individual differently, but should increase Social Security benefits for a significant majority of individuals who would be subject to WEP under current law.

While the bill does not fully repeal WEP, it does represent a significant improvement over the status quo for CSRS retirees unfairly penalized for their public service – and for that reason, NARFE supports the bill. Please contact your representatives today to urge them to cosponsor the bill.

#### **FEHB and FEDVIP Premium Increase**

The Office of Personnel Management (OPM) has announced the average Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Program premium for America's retired and active federal workers will increase 1.3% in 2019, with the average enrollee's share rising 1.5%. This is the lowest increase since 1996.

FEHBP premiums increased 3.8% in 2012, 3.4% in 2013, 3.7% in 2014, 3.2% in 2015, 6.4% in 2016, 4.4% in 2017, and 4.0% in 2018. Note: Kaiser High Option is increasing 15% (\$451.06). Kaiser continues to oppose Self Plus One by pricing that is \$70.60 higher than Self Plus Family.

Federal Employees Dental and Vision Program (FEDVIP) plans will see the overall average premium for dental plans will increase by 1.2%, while the overall average premium for vision plans will decrease by 2.8%.



#### **FEHB OPEN SEASON**

Open Season will take place between November 12 and December 10, 2018. This will be an opportunity for the federal community to assess various coverage options and select the plans that meet their healthcare and financial needs. Enrollees' new health plans will then become effective January 1, 2019. **FEHBP rates & brochures for 2019 are now on our website.** It includes 2019 Rates, 2019 Plan Brochures, 2019 Changes, Links to the providers website. # **ALZHEIMER'S INFORMATION**

#### **Alzheimer's Disease Funded by Congress**

At the end of September, the largest-ever funding increase for Alzheimer's and dementia research at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) was signed into law. The \$425 million increase was advocated for by the Alzheimer's Association, the Alzheimer's Impact Movement (AIM) and its nationwide network of dedicated advocates — including the dedicated members of NARFE. This action shows that Congress remains fully committed to the fight to end Alzheimer's.
